



OHIO EAGLES ATHLETICS COVID POLICY IN REGARD TO VISITING TEAMS

PLAYERS, COACHES, ATHLETIC TRAINERS, AND OFFICIALS

- We ask that you do your health assessments before arriving at our facility.
- Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
- No congregating inside the facility before or after events. You are welcome to do so while social distancing in the parking lot.
- The State of Ohio has issued a mask mandate for all players not on the court, coaches not actively directing a team, volunteers, and officials not actively officiating. Exceptions are made for those with qualifying medical reasons.
- Players, coaches, and officials are not to physically contact each other (greetings, team huddles, high-fives).

SPECTATORS

- We ask that all spectators do their health assessments before arriving at our facility.
- Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
- Family members should sit as a group and not with other families.
- No congregating inside the facility before or after events. You are welcome to do so while social distancing in the parking lot.
- The State of Ohio has issued a mask mandate. Exceptions are made for those with qualifying medical reasons.
- Our bleacher capacity for spectators is 250. 15% is 37 spectators. Players/coaches waiting for their games to start and volunteers are not considered spectators and will have a separate location to sit. We regretfully ask that each player only bring 2 spectators during this time.
- Cost of admission is \$5 per person over the age of 5.

GAMES, TOURNAMENTS, EQUIPMENT

- Please bring your own equipment for all pregame warmups.
- Each player should have their own water bottle. Our drinking fountain is currently shut off to eliminate possible community spread.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in the front lobby as well as team bench areas.
- Our locker rooms are currently closed. Please come already dressed. Bathroom facilities are open.
- Our concession stand is limited to individually wrapped snacks as well as drinks.
